



**RECISSION OF EMERGENCY DESIGNATION OF SHELLFISH LANDS
IN THE STATE OF NEW YORK
AS CLOSED FOR THE HARVEST OF SHELLFISH AND CARNIVOROUS GASTROPODS**


Pursuant to the provisions of Subdivisions 13-0307 (1) and (2) and Subdivision 13-0309 (1) and Subdivision 13-0330 (6) of the Environmental Conservation Law and Sections 42.17, 47.4 and 50.1 of Title 6 of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York, and based on a determination that marine biotoxins are no longer present in shellfish at levels which may cause shellfish and carnivorous gastropods to be hazardous for use as food, I, Debra A. Barnes, Chief, Bureau of Shellfisheries, Division of Marine Resources of the Department of Environmental Conservation, hereby rescind the specific sections in the order dated April 16, 2025, which prohibited the harvest of shellfish and carnivorous gastropods from particular underwater lands in Shinnecock Bay. **This order is effective at 1:00 PM, EST, Friday, June 6, 2025.**

Accordingly, the harvest of shellfish and carnivorous gastropods from the following areas is permitted:

- 1. Town of Southampton:** All the normally certified areas of Shinnecock Bay, including its tributaries.
